- Are a thriving community that values the unique gifts, talents, and contributions of every team member.
- Proactively identify challenges and embrace creative solutions that lead to outstanding resident care.

BE RESPONSIBLE!

Whoever can be trusted with very little can also be trusted with much... (Luke 16:10a)

To BE RESPONSIBLE means that we:

- ❖ Take responsibility for our decisions and behaviors, always striving to do the right thing.
- Hold ourselves to the highest ethical standards, doing what is right even when it's difficult.
- Understand that our individual actions impact the overall reputation of our organization, and we take pride in representing it well.

❖ Act upon honest and direct feedback and embrace training and development opportunities, thereby fostering a culture of open communication and growth.

To SERVE TOGETHER means that we:

- Proactively offer help to colleagues, looking for opportunities to assist and elevate team performance.
